5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 19-14-110 is created to read:

9 19-14-110. Honorary high school diploma for veterans.

- 11 (a) The following individuals who have attended a
- 12 Wyoming high school, entered military service on the dates
- 13 specified below prior to completing necessary high school
- 14 graduation requirements and who did not receive a high
- 15 school diploma, may apply to the state superintendent of

1 public instruction for an honorary high school diploma in

2 accordance with this section:

4 (i) An honorably discharged veteran of the

5 Second World War, who served in the United States military

6 between December 8, 1941, and August 14, 1945;

7

8 (ii) An honorably discharged veteran of the

9 Korean War emergency, who served in the United States

10 military between June 27, 1950, and July 28, 1953;

11

12 (iii) An honorably discharged veteran of the

13 Vietnam War emergency, who served in the United States

14 military between February 28, 1961, and August 15, 1973.

15

16 (b) Application shall be filed by an eligible veteran

17 or a member of the veteran's immediate family on a form

18 prescribed by the state superintendent, together with

19 certification by the county clerk that the veteran has been

20 honorably discharged from one (1) of the military

21 operations specified under subsection (a) of this section.

22 The state superintendent shall, following review of the

23 application and upon approval, forward the application to

24 the school district with jurisdiction of the school within

1 the state that the veteran last attended prior to entering

2 military service.

4 (c) Upon receipt of an application transmitted by the state superintendent pursuant to subsection (b) of this 6 section, a school district shall award an honorary high 7 school diploma to the applicant veteran or to the applicant 8 family member on behalf of the veteran. An honorary 9 diploma issued under this section shall designate the high 10 school attended by the veteran and shall clearly specify
