1 subsection who are sixty-five (65) years of age and older 2 or who are eighteen (18) years of age and older and are 3 totally disabled during the one (1) year period immediately 4 preceding the date of application for a refund under this 5 subsection and are not residents of any state funded institution, are qualified for an exemption and refund of 6 7 state taxes as provided in this subsection. A qualified single person whose actual income is less than ten thousand 8 9 dollars (\$10,000.00) thirteen thousand dollars (\$13,000.00) 10 shall receive five hundred dollars (\$500.00) six hundred 11 fifty dollars (\$650.00) reduced by the percentage that his 12 actual income exceeds six thousand dollars (\$6,000.00) 13 seven thousand eight hundred dollars (\$7,800.00) per year 14 and qualified married persons, at least one (1) of whom is at least sixty-five (65) years of age or totally disabled, 15 16 whose actual income is less than fourteen thousand dollars 17 (\$14,000.00) eighteen thousand two hundred dollars (\$18,200.00) shall receive six hundred dollars (\$600.00) 18 seven hundred eighty dollars (\$780.00) reduced by the 19 20 percentage that their actual income exceeds eight thousand 21 dollars (\$8,000.00) ten thousand four hundred dollars 22 (\$10,400.00) per year. Until remarriage a person sixty (60) years or older once qualified through marriage remains 23

eligible individually for single person benefits, subject 1 2 to income limitations, after the death of his spouse; 3 4 (vii) No applicant is entitled to a refund under 5 this article who owns resources that exceed an equity value of four thousand five hundred dollars (\$4,500.00) five 6 7 thousand eight hundred dollars (\$5,800.00). In determining resources, a single one hundred thousand dollars 8 9 (\$100,000.00) one hundred thirty thousand dollars 10 (\$130,000.00) equity value of the combined property is 11 exempt: 12 13 Section 2. There is appropriated from the general fund to the department of health for purposes of this act, 14 two million three hundred thousand dollars (\$2,300,000.00). 15 16 17 This act is effective immediately upon Section 3. completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 18 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 19 20 Constitution. 21 22 (END)
