- 4 providing for a temporary county seat for Lincoln county;
- 5 providing for a county number for Fossil county; and
- 6 providing for an effective date.

(n) Lincoln county is that portion of the state of 1 2 Wyoming within the following boundaries: beginning at the 3 north one-quarter southwest corner of section three (3) 4 thirty-one (31), township eighteen (18)—twenty-nine (29) 5 north, range one hundred twelve (112) one hundred fifteen (115) west; thence west along the township line between 6 7 townships eighteen (18) twenty-eight (28) and nineteen (19) twenty-nine (29) north to the intersection of the said 8 9 township line with the western boundary of the state of Wyoming; thence north along said western boundary of the 10 11 state of Wyoming to the intersection of said boundary with 12 the township line between township thirty-eight (38) north 13 and township thirty-nine (39) north; thence east along the township line between township thirty-eight (38) 14 15 thirty-nine (39) north to the southeast corner of section thirty-six (36), township thirty-nine (39) north, range one 16 17 hundred eighteen (118) west; thence south along the range line to the southwest corner of section thirty (30), 18 township thirty-nine (39) north, range 19 hundred one 20 seventeen (117) west; thence east along the section lines 21 to the southeast corner of section twenty-five (25), 22 township thirty-nine (39) north, range one hundred 23 seventeen (117) west unsurveyed; thence south to the 24 southwest corner of section nineteen (19), township

section thirty-two (32), township twenty-five (25) north, 1 2 range one hundred eleven (111) west; thence along the sixth 3 (6th) standard parallel to the north one-quarter corner of 4 section six (6), township twenty-four (24) north, range one 5 hundred eleven (111) west; thence south through the centers of sections and through one-quarter corners to the south 6 7 one-quarter corner of section thirty-one (31), township 8 twenty-one (21) north, range one hundred eleven (111) west; 9 thence along the fifth (5th) standard parallel to the north 10 one-quarter corner of section three (3), township twenty 11 (20) north, range one hundred twelve (112) west; thence 12 south through the centers of sections and through 13 one-quarter corners to the point of beginning.

- 13 county shall belong to and be a part of Lincoln county for
- 14 all purposes.

- 16 (c) Upon passage of a proposition for the
- 17 organization of Fossil county as provide by W.S. 18-1-308,
- 18 the joint corporations, elections and political
- 19 subdivisions interim committee shall report to the
- 20 following session of the legislature concerning necessary
