2	(i) The county assessor, part-time county and
3	prosecuting attorneys, part-time county attorneys, county
4	clerk, clerk of district court, county sheriff and county
5	treasurer in their respective counties shall receive not
6	less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) nor more than
7	twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) as annual
8	salaries <u>:</u> -
9	
10	(A) From and after January 1, 1983, the
11	specified county officers shall receive an annual salary of
12	not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) nor more
13	than forty thousand dollars (\$40,000.00). Full-time county
14	and prosecuting attorneys shall receive not less than
15	thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000.00) and not more than
16	forty-five thousand dollars (\$45,000.00) as annual
17	salaries. From and after January 1, 1995, the specified
18	full-time county officers shall receive an annual salary
19	not less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) nor more
20	than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00). Full-time county
21	attorneys shall receive not less than thirty thousand
22	dollars (\$30,000.00) nor more than sixty thousand dollars
23	(\$60,000.00) as annual salaries. Full-time county and
24	prosecuting attorneys shall receive not less than thirty-

1	five thousand dollars (\$35,000.00) nor more than sixty
2	thousand dollars (\$60,000.00) as annual salaries. From and
3	after January 1, 1999, the specified full-time county
4	officers shall receive an annual salary not less than ten
5	thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) nor more than sixty thousand
6	dollars (\$60,000.00) <u>;</u> -

8	(B) From and after January 1, 2007, not
9	less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) nor more than
10	seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000.00).

12	(ii) Full-time county attorneys shall receive
13	not less than thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00) nor more
14	than seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000.00) as annual
15	salaries. and full-time county and prosecuting attorneys
16	shall receive <u>as annual salaries:</u>

18	(A) From and after January 1, 1999, not
19	less than thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000.00) nor
20	more than seventy thousand dollars (\$70,000.00) <u>; as annual</u>

2	less than thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000.00) nor
3	more than eighty-five thousand dollars (\$85,000.00).

5	(iii) Salaries shall be paid in equal monthly
6	installments. The board of county commissioners of each
7	county shall meet not later than June 1, 1978, and on or
8	before the same date each four (4) years thereafter, for
9	the purpose of setting salaries, which shall not be changed
10	during the term of each official for whom a salary is
11	determined.

13	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2004.
