1 AN ACT relating to insurance; requiring additional 2 information on medical malpractice claims to be reported; and providing for an effective date. 3 4 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 5 6 7 Section 1. W.S. 26-3-124(a) by creating new paragraphs (iv) and (v) and (b) is amended to read: 8 9 26-3-124. Annual statement; mandatory reporting of 10 11 claims against health care providers; confidentiality; abstract of statistics. 12 13 14 (a) Any insurer writing coverage for health care 15 malpractice in this state, by March 1 of each year, shall file with the commissioner a report of all claims against a 16 17 health care provider and a report of all awards or

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1	settlements given in cases against health care providers.
2	The report shall contain the following information only for
3	the preceding calendar year:
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5	(iv) For each claim:
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7	(A) Specialty coverage of the insured;
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9	(B) Insured's policy number;
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11	(C) Nature and substance of the claim;
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13	(D) Date on which the claim arose;
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15	(E) Age of the claimant or plaintiff;
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17	(F) After final disposition of the claim,
18	the date and manner of disposition, whether by judgment,
19	settlement or otherwise, and an itemization of the amounts
20	<pre>paid, if any, for:</pre>

22	(I) Medical and prescription costs;
23	
24	(II) Economic damages;

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2	(III) Noneconomic damages;
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4	(IV) Attorneys fees, costs and
5	expenses.
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7	(G) Any additional information required by
8	the commissioner.
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10	(v) The number of claims against an insured if
11	more than one (1) claim has been filed against the insured
12	in the preceding calendar year, without revealing the
13	identity of the insured.
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15	(b) The names of health care providers <del>and <mark>shall not</mark></del>
16	be disclosed in information reported under subsection (a)
17	of this section. Any records pertaining thereto are
18	confidential. The commissioner shall prepare an abstract of
19	all pertinent statistics for inclusion in his annual report
20	to the governor pursuant to W.S. 9-2-1014.
21	
22	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2004.
