## for

1 AN ACT relating to school finance; providing assistance to 2 school districts for provision of full-day kindergarten 3 programs; imposing duties upon the department of education; 4 requiring district reporting; providing an appropriation; 5 and providing for an effective date.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 8

9 Section 1.

11 (a) To provide financial assistance to school 12 districts for the provision of full-day kindergarten 13 programs, each school district shall for school year 2004-14 2005, receive an amount payable from the school foundation 15 program account determined in accordance with subsection 16 (b) of this section. This payment shall be made by the

1 department of education from amounts within the foundation 2 account appropriated by the legislature for program 3 purposes of this section and shall be in addition to the 4 foundation program amount determined for each district 5 under W.S. 21-13-309(p). If there is an insufficient amount within the foundation program account for payments 6 7 under this section, the department shall make a pro rata in the payments to districts for 8 reduction each 9 kindergarten student.

11 (b) Payments to school districts for full-day 12 kindergarten programs shall be computed by multiplying the 13 number of students enrolled in full-day kindergarten programs within each district during school year 2004-2005 14 by one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), and 15 shall be 16 distributed to districts on February 15 together with 17 foundation program distributions for school year 2004-2005 under W.S. 21-13-313. For purposes of computations under 18 this subsection, the kindergarten enrollment count for each 19 20 district shall be the enrollment taken during October 2004.

(c) Each district shall report expenditures to the department in the manner and at the time specified by the department. The department shall compile the reports and

1 submit the compilation to the joint education interim 2 committee. 3 4 Section 2. Six million dollars (\$6,000,000.00) is 5 appropriated from the school foundation program account to

6 the department of education for distributions to school 7 districts for full-day kindergarten programs pursuant to 8 section 1 of this act.

10 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2004.
