(xxii) "Trust advisor" means the settlor of a 1 2 trust instrument or other parties whose appointment is 3 provided in the trust instrument and whose powers are 4 defined and limited in W.S. 4-10-712; 5 (xxiii) "Trust protector" means 6 any 7 disinterested party whose appointment is provided for in the trust instrument or who is appointed by a court of 8 9 competent jurisdiction and whose powers are defined and <del>limited</del> in W.S. 4-10-710; 10 11 12 4-10-710. Trust protector. 13 14 (a) The powers and discretions of a trust protector shall be provided in the trust instrument or may be 15 established or modified by a judicial order, and may, in 16 17 the best interests of the trust, be exercised or not 18 exercised. The powers and discretions may include, but are not limited to the following: 19 20 21 4-10-712. Trust advisor. 22 The powers and discretions of a trust advisor 23 (a) 24 shall be provided in the trust instrument and may, in the
