1 (c) To qualify for immunity under subsection (b) of

2 this section, a **volunteer** health care professional shall do

3 all of the following prior to the initial diagnosis, care

4 or treatment:

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(d) Except as provided in this subsection, the 6 7 immunities provided by subsection (b) of this section are not available to a volunteer health care professional, if 8 9 at the time of an alleged injury, death or loss to person 10 property, the volunteer health care professional 11 involved was performing an operation or delivering a baby. 12 This subsection does not apply to a volunteer health care 13 professional who provides diagnosis, care or treatment or 14 performs an operation or delivers a baby when necessary to

preserve the life of a person in a medical emergency.

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(e) In order for the immunity under subsection (b) of
this section to apply and before the rendering of any
services by the <u>volunteer</u> health care professional at the
nonprofit health care facility, there must be a written
agreement between the <u>volunteer</u> health care professional
and the facility pursuant to which the <u>volunteer</u> health
care professional will provide medical, dental or health

2 of the facility to patients of the facility.

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4 (f) A nonprofit health care facility entering into a 5 written agreement under subsection (e) of this section shall maintain liability coverage of not less than one 6 million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence, except that 7 no such coverage shall be required to be maintained by the 8 9 facility if such coverage is maintained by the volunteer health care professional. A nonprofit health care facility 10 11 shall be liable for the negligent acts of a volunteer 12 health care professional providing diagnosis, care 13 treatment at the facility only in the circumstances and to
