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- 8 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-26-102(a)(intro), (i), (ii), (b)
- 9 and by creating a new subsection (c) and 35-26-103(b) and
- 10 (c) are amended to read:

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12 **35-26-102**. Use of automated external defibrillator.

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- 14 (a) In order to ensure public health and safety, any
- 15 person who acquires all persons who use an AED shall:
- 16 ensure that:

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2	(i) Expected defibrillator users receive Obtain
3	appropriate training in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
4	and in the use of an AED by the American Heart Association,
5	American Red Cross or by another nationally recognized, or
6	Wyoming department of health recognized, course in CPR and
7	AED use and maintains currency through refresher training
8	every two (2) years; and
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10	(ii) <u>Ensure that t</u> he AED is maintained and
11	tested according to the manufacturer's guidelines $\underline{\cdot}$
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13	(b) Any person who acquires or entity in possession
14	of an AED shall notify an agent of the emergency
15	communications center and the local ambulance service of
16	the existence, location and type of AED.
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18	(c) Any person who uses an AED shall notify an agent
19	of the emergency communications center and the local
20	ambulance service upon each use of the AED.

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(b) The Any prescribing physician who authorizes the 1 2 purchase of the AED, the any individual who provides 3 training in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and the use 4 of an AED, and the person responsible for the site where 5 the AED is located shall also be immune from civil 6 liability for any personal injury that results from any act 7 or omission of acts that do not amount to willful or wanton misconduct or gross negligence if that person complies with 8 9 the requirements of W.S. 35-26-102. 10 11 (c) Any clinical use of the AED shall be reported to 12 the a licensed physician at the clinic where the AED is 13 used. 14 15 **Section 2.** W.S. 35-26-102(a)(iii) is repealed. 16 17 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2004. 18 19 (END)

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
