Billboard reductions.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to outdoor advertising; providing for the  
2 reduction in size of billboards as specified; conforming  
3 provisions; providing for the dismantling and removal of  
4 noncompliant billboards as specified; repealing the  
5 requirement for payment of compensation; and providing for  
6 an effective date.

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8 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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10 **Section 1.** W.S. 24-10-106(a), (b)(intro) and by  
11 creating a new subsection (m), 24-10-107(b) and  
12 24-10-109(a)(iii) and by creating a new paragraph (iv) are  
13 amended to read:

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15 **24-10-106. Size, lighting and spacing; where signs**  
16 **may be erected.**

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2 (a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, the  
3 minimum standards and criteria for the size, lighting and  
4 spacing of outdoor advertising, and the criteria for  
5 unzoned commercial or industrial zones or areas within the  
6 controlled area along the interstate and primary systems  
7 designated in W.S. 24-10-104 shall conform to those  
8 promulgated and submitted by the secretary of  
9 transportation to the congress of the United States on or  
10 about January 10, 1967.

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12 (b) No sign face within the state of Wyoming, erected  
13 and permitted under W.S. 24-10-107(b) prior to April 1,  
14 2004, shall exceed the following limits:

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16 (m) No sign face within the state of Wyoming,  
17 permitted under W.S. 24-10-107(b) and erected on or after  
18 April 1, 2004, shall exceed one hundred fifty (150) square  
19 feet. Any sign face exceeding one hundred fifty (150)  
20 square feet and permitted prior to April 1, 2004, shall be  
21 reduced in size to comply with the limitations in this  
22 section no later than January 1, 2014, or the sign shall  
23 otherwise be dismantled and removed. No compensation shall

1 be paid for any sign that is dismantled and removed to be  
2 in compliance with this section.

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4 **24-10-107. Permits and identification tags.**

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6 (b) Permits shall be for three (3) years, shall be  
7 assigned a permit number, and shall be renewed annually  
8 thereafter upon payment of five dollars (\$5.00) without the  
9 filing of a new application. On or after April 1, 2004, new  
10 permits shall only be issued for outdoor advertising signs,  
11 displays or devices that do not exceed a sign face of one  
12 hundred fifty (150) square feet. All fees shall be paid  
13 into the state highway fund. All such fees collected shall  
14 be used by the commission for relocation or damages, but  
15 not for administrative purposes.

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17 **24-10-109. What outdoor advertising deemed unlawful;**  
18 **procedure for removal.**

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20 (a) The following outdoor advertising is deemed  
21 unlawful:

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23 (iii) When a permittee fails to comply with a  
24 notice of violation as provided in W.S. 24-10-108; ~~or~~ or

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(iv) Effective January 1, 2014, signs, displays and devices exceeding the size limits specified in W.S. 24-10-106(m) shall not be allowed and such signs, displays and devices shall be dismantled and removed no later than January 31, 2014.

**Section 2.** W.S. 16-8-101 is repealed.

**Section 3.** This act is effective immediately upon completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution.
