The loan is 21 not deemed to be a general obligation of the city, town or 22 county, and the state shall not require repayment from any

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2 (d) Deposits into the account created by subsection 3 (a) of this section shall be distributed as follows, 4 subject to subsections (b) and (c) of this section: 5 6 (i) To the general fund, sixty-two and twenty-7 six hundredths percent (62.26%) fifty-four and twenty-six 8 hundredths percent (54.26%); 9 10 (vi) To counties, three and one-tenth percent 11 (3.1%)—seven and one-tenth percent (7.1%), each county to 12 receive an amount in the proportion which the population of 13 the county bears to total state population, population to be determined by resort to the latest federal census as 14 periodically updated by the bureau of the census; 15 16 17 (viii) To cities and towns, nine and twenty-five hundredths percent (9.25%) thirteen and twenty-five 18 hundredths percent (13.25%), each city or town to receive 19 20 an amount in the proportion which the population of the 21 city or town bears to the population of all cities and 22 towns in Wyoming, population to be determined by resort to the latest federal census as periodically updated by the 23 24 bureau of the census;

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Section 2. This act shall be applied to revenues a earned on or after July 1, 2004.
