for

1 AN ACT relating to taxation and revenue; specifying
2 documents that must be filed by special districts; making
3 conforming amendments; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 22-29-103(e) (intro) and
8 39-13-104(k) (iv) (intro) and (A) are amended to read:

9

10 **22-29-103. Applicability to special districts;**
11 **general provisions.**

12

13 (e) All special districts having the power to levy or
14 to require the levy of ad valorem taxes shall file ~~a copy~~
15 ~~of the legal description which is contained within the~~
16 ~~document authorizing formation or modification of~~
17 ~~boundaries and a copy of an official map designating~~

1 documents that, as determined by the department of revenue,
2 accurately reflect the geographical boundaries of the
3 district or the changes to its geographical boundaries with
4 the department of revenue, the county assessor and the
5 county clerk in the county or counties within which the
6 entity is located as follows:

8 **39-13-104. Taxation rate.**

9

10 (k) The following shall apply to the certification of
11 tax levies:

12

13 (iv) Each special district shall demonstrate to
14 the county commissioners that ~~a legal description and map~~
15 documents have been filed with the department, the county
16 clerk and the county assessor that accurately reflect the
17 property within the district, as follows:

18

19 (A) Annually, the department and the county
20 assessor shall issue a notice of compliance to each special
21 district having the power to levy or to require the levy of
22 ad valorem taxes that has filed ~~a legal description and map~~
23 documents that, as determined by the department, accurately

1 ~~showing~~reflect the geographical boundaries of the district
2 to date;

4 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2004.
