A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to public schools; requiring school boards  
2 to observe a minute of silence in schools; and providing  
3 for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 21-3-110(a) by creating a new  
8 paragraph (xxix) is amended to read:

10 **21-3-110. Duties of boards of trustees.**

12 (a) The board of trustees in each school district  
13 shall:

14

15 (xxix) At the beginning of the first class of  
16 each school day, provide for the observance of not less

1 than one (1) minute during which a student may reflect,  
2 pray, meditate or engage in any other silent activity that  
3 is not likely to interfere with or distract another  
4 student. The board shall require the district  
5 superintendent and school principals to enforce this  
6 paragraph.

8 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2004.
