- 12 (a) The commission may grant a manufacturer's license
- 13 authorizing the manufacture or rectification of alcoholic
- 14 liquor or malt beverages or an importer's license
- 15 authorizing the importation of alcoholic liquor to a
- 16 qualified resident within this state who submit submits an

application to the commission on forms provided by the 1

commission and pays an annual license fee of two hundred 2

fifty dollars (\$250.00) for each license. A person may be 3

issued both a manufacturer's license and an 4 importer's

5 license.

7 The Wyoming liquor division shall may grant an a (b) class A industry representative license for alcoholic 8 9 liquor suppliers to a qualified individual domiciled within this state who submits an application to the division on 10 11 forms provided by the division accompanied by an annual 12 license fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) not to exceed 13 seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00). A class A industry 14 representative shall have a written statement from any vendor whose products the applicant proposes to represent. 15 The class A industry representative shall be published in 16 17 the division's price catalog with the products from any vendor represented by him and shall be authorized to 18 19 request that the division list or delist products from the 20 vendor represented by him.

22 (c) The division may grant a class B industry 23 representative license for alcohol liquor suppliers to a 24 qualified individual domiciled within this state who

- 4 industry representative shall be employed or managed by a

- 10 (d) The division may grant a class C temporary
- special event industry representative license to any 11
- 12 individual twenty-one (21) years of age or older who
- 13 submits an application on a form supplied by the division
- 14 for a fee of not to exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00) per
- 15 event.

- 17 (e) No class A, B or C industry representative shall
- 18 be employed by a licensee as defined by W.S.
- 19 12-1-101(a)(viii).
