Any member receiving educational 13 assistance under the plan who fails to earn a cumulative 14 grade point average at least equivalent to 2.0 on a 4.0 15 scale shall be ineligible for educational assistance under 16 17 the plan until the member attains that cumulative grade point average, unless the adjutant general for cause and 18 19 pursuant to rule and regulation waives the grade point 20 average requirement.
