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5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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7 **Section 1** W.S. 39-13-105(b) is amended to read:

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9 **39-13-105**. Exemptions; veterans.

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- 11 (b) The exemption for veterans is limited to an
- 12 annual exemption of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) of
- 13 assessed value and not to exceed a total tax benefit of
- 14 eight hundred dollars (\$800.00) except as hereafter
- 15 provided. The eight hundred dollar (\$800.00) limitation
- 16 does not apply to qualified widows of veterans nor veterans

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of the Spanish American War. Veterans who have received the 1 2 entire eight hundred dollar (\$800.00) exemption and who 3 have a service connected disability certified by the 4 veterans administration or a branch of the armed forces of 5 the United States, or who have been granted individual unemployability status certified by the United States 6 7 veterans administration, are entitled to additional annual tax exemptions not to exceed two thousand dollars 8 9 (\$2,000.00) of assessed value times the ratio which the percent of disability certified bears to one hundred 10 11 percent (100%). Disability certified less than ten percent 12 (10%) shall be treated as a ten percent (10%) disability. 13 14 Section 2. This act is effective January 1, 2005.
