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- 7 **Section 1.** W.S. 12-4-502(c) and (d) is amended to
- 8 read:

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- 10 12-4-502. Twenty-four hour malt beverage permit and
- 11 catering permit; restrictions; application procedure; fees.

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- 13 (c) The permits authorized by this section shall be
- 14 issued for one (1) twenty-four (24) hour period, subject to
- 15 the schedule of operating hours provided by W.S. 12-5-101.
- 16 No person or organization shall receive more than a total

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1 of twelve (12) malt beverage and eighteen (18) catering

2 permits for sales at the same premises in any one (1) year,

3 except that this limitation shall not be applicable to malt

4 beverage permits issued for sales at any fair, rodeo, pari-

5 mutuel event or other similar public event conducted by a

public entity upon public premises. 6

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The malt beverage permit and the catering permit 8 (d)

9 shall be issued on application to the appropriate licensing

10 authority without public notice or hearing. An application

11 for a malt beverage permit or catering permit under this

12 section shall be accompanied by a designation of the event

13 for which the application is sought specifying the type of

14 event and the name of the sponsor. Any applicant applying

for a permit authorized by this section and having licensed 15

premises located within a jurisdiction other than that 16

17 jurisdiction to which application is made, shall secure the

written approval of the licensing authority of that 18

jurisdiction in which the licensed premises are located 19

20 prior to filing an application for a permit.
