W.S. 33-26-504(f) and by creating a new subsection (g) is amended to read: 8 9 10 33-26-504. License required; application; 11 qualifications; consideration of applications. 12 (f) The board, with the concurrence of the advisory 13 14 committee, shall approve an application by a licensed physician to supervise a physician assistant if the board 15 16 is satisfied that the proposed physician assistant is a

1	graduate of an approved program, has satisfactorily
2	completed a certification examination and is fully
3	qualified to assist in the practice of medicine under the
4	responsible supervision of a licensed physician. <u>It shall</u>
5	be the policy of the board to allow four (4) physician
6	assistants per physician and the board and the advisory
7	committee shall not deny an application due to number of
8	physician assistants supervised up to four (4), except for
9	good cause specific to the circumstances of that individual
10	physician.

12	(g) The board may allow arrangements for other
13	physicians to serve as back up or on call physicians for
14	multiple physician assistants.

16	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2005.
