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8	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:
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10	Section 1. W.S. 9-2-1013(d)(i), 9-5-101 by creating a
11	new subsection (d) and 9-5-106(b) are amended to read:
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13	9-2-1013. State budget; distribution of copies to
14	legislators; copies and reports of authorizations.
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In addition to the items contained in subsection 1 (d) 2 section and notwithstanding any other (a) of this recommendations made by the governor, the state budget 3 4 shall also include the governor's recommendations for 5 appropriations for the ensuing two (2) years, or if a supplemental budget request, the remainder of the budget 6 7 period, subject to the following:

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9 (i) The budget shall include state the governor's recommendations for a total appropriation from 10 11 the school foundation program account and based upon 12 recommendations of the school facilities commission under 13 W.S. 21-15-119, a total appropriation for school capital 14 construction purposes for both fiscal years. The state budget shall include the state building commission's and 15 16 governor's recommendations for appropriations for state 17 capital construction based upon the needs assessment and construction schedule under W.S. 9-5-107 and 9-5-108 for 18 19 both fiscal years;

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1	(d) The state building commission shall employ a
2	secretary who shall administratively implement any rules of
3	the commission adopted under this article and perform other
4	duties and functions of the commission as may be assigned
5	by the commission. The secretary of the commission shall be
6	employed upon a majority vote of the commission and serve
7	at the pleasure of a majority of the commission. The
8	commission shall establish compensation for its secretary
9	subject to legislative budget authorization.

12	to use of state buildings; rules authorized; exceptions.
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14	(b) <del>The secretary to the commission under W.S.</del>
15	9-2-1016(b)(xxi) shall administratively implement any rules
16	of the state building commission adopted under this
17	section. The director of the department of administration
18	and information may adopt rules and regulations which make
19	violation of rules adopted by the commission under
20	subsection (a) of this section grounds for disciplinary
21	action for any state employee violating the rules of the
22	state building commission regarding operation, management

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Section 2. W.S. 9-2-1016(b)(xxi) is repealed.

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3 Section 3. The position of the manager of the 4 construction management section within the authorized 5 budget of the department of administration and information together with the remaining budget associated for that 6 7 position for the fiscal biennium ending June 30, 2008 shall be transferred to the state building commission. The 8 9 position shall act as secretary to the commission in accordance with this act. 10

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12 Section 4. This act is effective January 1, 2007.
