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This chapter is known and may be cited as the "Wyoming 1 2 Commonsense Consumption Act". 3 11-46-102. Definitions. 4 5 (a) As used in this act: 6 7 (i) "Livestock" means as defined in W.S. 8 9 11-39-101(a)(vi); 10 (ii) "Agricultural producer" means any producer 11 12 of livestock, crops for food or fiber, dairy products and 13 any other product for human consumption from an agricultural operation; 14 15 16 (iii) "Long term consumption" means the 17 cumulative effect of the consumption of any qualified product and not the effect of a single instance of 18 consumption; 19 20 21 (iv) "Qualified product" means any food or drink as defined in section 201(f) of the Federal Food Drug and 22 23 Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C. § 321(f)), and specifically 24 includes meat and meat products from livestock, food,

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fiber, dairy products and any other product for human 1 2 consumption from an agricultural operation; 3 (v) "Seller" means any person or entity lawfully 4 5 engaged in the business of marketing, distributing, advertising or selling a qualified product; 6 7 (vi) "Trade association" means any association 8 9 or business organization that is not operated for profit, if two (2) or more members are manufacturers, marketers, 10 or 11 distributors, agricultural producers, advertisers 12 sellers of a qualified product; 13

(vii) "Public aid organization" means 14 any organization which provides food or drink to members of the 15 16 public at a free or reduced charge. Public aid 17 organizations include, but are not limited to, organizations such as homeless shelters, soup kitchens and 18 19 food banks;

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21 (viii) "This act" means W.S. 11-46-101 through 22 11-46-103.

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11-46-103. Limitation on liability for long term
 consumption.

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4 (a) No manufacturer, seller, trade association, 5 agricultural producer, wholesaler, broker or retailer of a qualified product or hospital, senior citizen center, 6 7 nursing home or public aid organization is subject to civil liability for injury or death in any case in which 8 9 liability is based on the individual's weight gain, obesity or a health condition related to weight gain or obesity, 10 and the weight gain, obesity or health condition results 11 12 from the individual's long term consumption of a qualified 13 product.

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15 (b) Subsection (a) of this section shall not preclude 16 civil liability if:

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18 (i) The claim of injury or death is based on a 19 material violation of a composition, branding or labeling 20 standard prescribed by state or federal law; and

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(A) The claimed injury or death was
actually and proximately caused by that violation; and

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1 (B) The violation was committed with intent 2 to deceive or injure consumers or with actual knowledge 3 that the violation was injurious to consumers. 4

5 Section 2. This act applies to any action commenced on or after the effective date of this act. 6

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Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon 8 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 9 10 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming Constitution. 11
