16	individual submitting the sample for diagnosis unless:

(iii) The release of the information is required
by state or federal law. Nothing in this subsection shall
affect the duty of the Wyoming state veterinary laboratory
or any other person to report contagious or infectious
diseases as required by state or federal law.
