9 **Section 1.** W.S. 11-18-117 is created to read:

- 14 (a) All records, data and information collected by
- 15 the state, recorded or otherwise, for the purposes of a
- 16 national livestock identification program shall be

1 confidential and are not public records for purposes of 2 W.S. 16-4-201 through 16-4-205. The records, data and 3 information shall be released only upon order of the 4 Wyoming livestock board to appropriate governmental 5 agencies for the purposes of a national livestock identification program. The board shall not release any 6 7 records, data or information to a federal agency until the agency confirms in writing that it will maintain the 8 9 records, data and information as confidential and that they 10 are not subject to the federal Freedom of Information Act, 11 5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended. Upon release by the board of 12 any information to any other governmental entity, the board 13 shall notify the person to whom the information refers or pertains that the release has been made, the name of the 14 entity to whom the information was released and shall 15 16 provide a copy or summary of the information contained in 17 the release. The records, data and information shall not be subject to discovery or introduction into evidence in 18 any civil action. 19

21 (b) A person who knowingly provides false information 22 to the Wyoming livestock board for purposes of a national 23 livestock identification program shall be guilty of a 24 misdemeanor punishable by a fine of up to one thousand

2 or both.

4 (c) A person who refuses to provide to the livestock

5 board information that is required under federal law for

purposes of a national livestock identification program 6

7 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of up

to one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), imprisonment for up to 8

9 six (6) months, or both.

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2005. 11
