W.S. 2-8-102 is amended to read: 8 2-8-102. Contents of petition; notice of hearing. 9 10 Any heir at law, devisee or creditor whose claim was 11 allowed but not satisfied in the original administration or 12 13 other person interested may petition for the reopening of 14 the estate upon the grounds specified in W.S. 2-8-101. The 15 petition shall set forth the names of all heirs at law, 16 devisees and creditors and their address, if known. If the address is unknown to the petitioner he shall so state in 17

1	the petition. Upon filing of the petition, the clork <u>court</u>
2	shall appoint a day for hearing the petition and $\frac{the}{the}$
3	petitioner shall give notice thereof by mailing by
4	registered certified letter a copy of the notice to the
5	heirs at law, devisees and creditors named in the petition.
6	Where an address is unknown notice shall be served as
7	provided in the Wyoming Rules of Civil Procedure.

9	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2005.
