A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to alcoholic beverages; providing for  
2 industry representatives as specified; providing for  
3 licensure and fees; and providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 12-2-203 is amended to read:

9 **12-2-203. Manufacturing and rectifying; importing and**  
10 **industry representatives; licensing; fees.**

12 (a) The commission may grant a manufacturer's license  
13 authorizing the manufacture or rectification of alcoholic  
14 liquor or malt beverages or an importer's license  
15 authorizing the importation of alcoholic liquor to a  
16 qualified resident within this state who ~~submit~~submits an

1 application to the commission on forms provided by the  
2 commission and pays an annual license fee of two hundred  
3 fifty dollars (\$250.00) for each license. A person may be  
4 issued both a manufacturer's license and an importer's  
5 license.

6  
7 (b) The Wyoming liquor division ~~shall~~may grant ~~an~~a  
8 class A industry representative license for alcoholic  
9 liquor suppliers to a qualified individual domiciled within  
10 this state who submits an application to the division on  
11 forms provided by the division accompanied by an annual  
12 license fee of ~~twenty five dollars (\$25.00)~~not to exceed  
13 seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00). A class A industry  
14 representative shall have a written statement from any  
15 vendor whose products the applicant proposes to represent.  
16 The class A industry representative shall be published in  
17 the division's price catalog with the products from any  
18 vendor represented by him and shall be authorized to  
19 request that the division list or delist products from the  
20 vendor represented by him.

21  
22 (c) The division may grant a class B industry  
23 representative license for alcohol liquor suppliers to a  
24 qualified individual domiciled within this state who

1 submits an application to the division on forms provided by  
2 the division accompanied by an annual license fee of not to  
3 exceed two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00). A class B  
4 industry representative shall be employed or managed by a  
5 class A industry representative. A class B industry  
6 representative shall have a written statement from the  
7 class A industry representative designating any vendor  
8 whose products he is authorized to represent.

9  
10 (d) The division may grant a class C temporary  
11 special event industry representative license to any  
12 individual twenty-one (21) years of age or older who  
13 submits an application on a form supplied by the division  
14 for a fee of not to exceed fifty dollars (\$50.00) per  
15 event.

16  
17 (e) No class A, B or C industry representative shall  
18 be employed by a licensee as defined by W.S.  
19 12-1-101(a) (viii).

21 **Section 2.** This act is effective July 1, 2005.
