AN ACT relating to controlled substances; authorizing a 1 methamphetamine initiative planning study as specified; 2 3 requiring a report; providing an appropriation; and 4 providing for an effective date. 5 6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming: 7 Section 1. 8 9 10 (a) There is appropriated one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) from the general fund to the 11 department of health to conduct a methamphetamine 12 initiative planning study. The department shall: 13

1 (i) Review the scope of the methamphetamine 2 problem as it exists in the state, utilizing statistics 3 developed by the division of criminal investigation within 4 the attorney general's office and other sources as 5 appropriate;

7 (ii) Examine efforts currently being employed to 8 address the problems associated with methamphetamine use, 9 its prevention, correction and treatment including efforts 10 by the department of health, the state's education system, 11 law enforcement, the courts, social service agencies, local 12 governments and the department of corrections and probation 13 and parole;

(iii) Determine the number of persons being treated for methamphetamine use, or needing treatment for methamphetamine use, within the state and the number of existing treatment beds available and potential treatment beds in health care and detention facilities in the state to provide the treatment for those persons in need of residential care;

23 (iv) Determine the current capacity and24 potential needs for intensive and other types of out-

1 patient treatment throughout the state by geographic 2 regions;

4 (v) Examine the existing capacity and procedures 5 for conducting and completing substance abuse evaluations ordered for methamphetamine use, abuse or distribution 6 7 under W.S. 7-13-1032, including the number of qualified evaluators available and conducting evaluations in the 8 9 state, the costs associated with the evaluations and any 10 recommendations improve the capacity, to quality, 11 efficiency and effectiveness of the evaluation process, as 12 necessary.

The department of health may contract with an 14 (b) independent entity to perform the study and report back to 15 the department with the results of the study, including the 16 identified need and current utilization of treatment 17 facilities in the state and any recommendations with 18 19 respect to any new options regarding programs and 20 facilities that may address the current and projected needs 21 for treatment of individuals as a result of methamphetamine 22 The study shall identify the needs by geographic use. regions within the state. 23

(c) After review of the contractor's report to the 1 2 department of health, the department shall submit its 3 findings and recommendations to the governor's substance 4 abuse and violent crime advisory board, the joint 5 appropriations interim committee, the joint labor, health and social services interim committee, the joint judiciary 6 7 interim committee and any select committee studying mental health and substance abuse services no later than October 8 9 15, 2005. The chairmen of the legislative committees 10 receiving the report from the department shall coordinate 11 efforts to review the problems and solutions identified by 12 the department of health prior to the 2006 budget session 13 of the legislature.
