Immunizations-administration by pharmacists.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming Pharmacy Act; authorizing
2 pharmacists and pharmacist interns to prescribe and
3 administer immunizations; and providing for an effective
4 date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 33-24-156 is created to read:

9

10 **33-24-156. Immunization administration.**

11

12 (a) A pharmacist licensed under this act may only
13 prescribe and administer immunizations recommended for
14 healthy adults as authorized by the board.

15

1 (b) A pharmacist licensed under this act may
2 administer immunizations to adults who are considered high
3 risk only by prescription from a licensed physician.

4
5 (c) The board, in cooperation with the Wyoming state
6 board of medicine, shall adopt rules specifying
7 immunizations allowed under this act and the requirements a
8 pharmacist shall meet in order to prescribe and administer
9 immunizations.

11 **Section 2.** W.S. 33-24-130 is amended to read:

12

13 **33-24-130. Exemptions; administration of drugs and**
14 **medicine.**

15

16 Unless otherwise provided by law, the provisions of this
17 act do not apply to administration of drugs and medicines,
18 or to persons engaged in the administration of drugs and
19 medicines. Administration of drugs and medicines, for the
20 purpose of this exclusion, is hereby defined as actual,
21 personal distribution to, or injection in, or application
22 to a particular human being, of substances or material
23 which has already been prepared, selected, measured,

1 packaged, and labeled, or otherwise specifically identified
2 by a person qualified to do so under the terms of this act.

3

4 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2005.
