A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to hospital districts; providing for the
 2 number of trustees to be elected for hospital districts;
 3 providing for appointment of additional trustee until next
 4 regular election; and providing for an effective date.

6 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8 **Section 1.** W.S. 35-2-404(a) is amended to read:

9

10 **35-2-404. Procedure for initial election of trustees;**
 11 **number, term of trustees; qualifications; disposition of**
 12 **ballots and affidavits.**

14 (a) An election of ~~six (6)~~ not less than five (5) nor
 15 more than seven (7) trustees shall be held in accordance
 16 with the Special District Elections Act of 1994 at the same

1 time as the election for the formation of the district. At
2 the election a board of ~~six (6)~~ trustees shall be elected
3 who shall serve without compensation to govern the affairs
4 of the district. ~~There~~ One-half (1/2) or a majority of the
5 board shall be elected ~~three (3) members~~ to serve until the
6 next succeeding district election and ~~three (3)~~ the balance
7 of the members shall be elected to serve until the second
8 succeeding district election and until their successors are
9 elected and qualified. Thereafter, members shall be elected
10 for terms of four (4) years. Subsequent elections shall be
11 held in accordance with the Special District Elections Act
12 of 1994.

13

14 **Section 2.** Any additional hospital district trustee
15 authorized pursuant to section 1 of this act shall be
16 appointed in accordance with W.S. 22-29-202. The appointee
17 shall serve until the next regular election for trustees of
18 the hospital district, at which time a trustee shall be
19 elected for a four (4) year term.

21 **Section 3.** This act is effective July 1, 2005.
