A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to taxation and revenue; providing
2 qualifications for the veterans tax exemption; and
3 providing for an effective date.

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5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

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7 **Section 1.** W.S. 39-13-105(a)(vi)(intro) and (R) is
8 amended to read:

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10 **39-13-105. Exemptions; veterans.**

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12 (a) The following persons who are bona fide Wyoming
13 residents for at least three (3) years at the time of
14 claiming the exemption are entitled to receive the tax
15 exemption provided by W.S. 39-11-105(a)(xxiv):

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1 (vi) An honorably discharged veteran who served
2 in the military service of the United States, who is a bona
3 fide Wyoming resident for at least three (3) years and who
4 served in one (1) of the below listed military operations
5 during the specified period and who was awarded the armed
6 forces expeditionary medal, the ~~Vietnam~~ southwest Asia
7 service medal, the Korean service defense medal, the Kosovo
8 campaign medal, the global war on terrorism expeditionary
9 medal or other authorized service or campaign medal:

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11 (R) Afghanistan, Iraq and other locations -
12 - Operation Enduring Freedom, Iraqi Freedom and Operation
13 Noble Eagle (Homeland Security) - from October 7, 2001 to a
14 date to be determined by the department of revenue.

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16 **Section 2.** This act is effective January 1, 2005.
