6 **Section 1.** W.S. 19-14-107(a) is amended to read:

- 8 19-14-107. Creation of veterans' commission;
- 9 composition; terms.

- 11 (a) A Wyoming veterans' commission is created within
- 12 the military department consisting of twelve (12) members,
- 13 not less than one (1) of whom shall reside in each judicial
- 14 district identified in W.S. 5-3-101, appointed by the
- 15 governor for staggered terms of  $\frac{1}{2}$  three (3) years.
- 16 Commencing with initial appointments made in 2005, four (4)

members of the board shall be appointed for a term of one 1 2 (1) year, four (4) members for a term of two (2) years and 3 four (4) members for a term of three (3) years. Terms 4 thereafter shall be three (3) years and staggered with one-5 third (1/3) of the members' terms expiring each year. 6 Appointments shall be made without regard to political 7 affiliation, sex, religion or ethnic background. The governor may remove any member as provided in W.S. 9-1-202. 8 9 A chairman shall be elected by the commission from among 10 its members and a new chairman elected every two (2) years 11 thereafter. 12

Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2005. 13
