Wyoming professional assistance program.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming professional assistance
2 program; extending program provisions to attorneys;
3 providing for disclosure of records to licensing agency
4 upon refusal of treatment; and providing for an effective
5 date.

7 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

8

9 **Section 1.** W.S. 33-1-115(a)(ii), (iii) and (d) by
10 creating a new paragraph (vi) is amended to read:

11

12 **33-1-115. Professional assistance programs for health**
13 **care providers and others as specified; confidentiality of**
14 **records.**

16 (a) As used in this section:

1

2 (ii) "Licensee" means any individual holding a
3 permit or license as a health care provider as a profession
4 or occupation regulated under this title or any individual
5 admitted to the Wyoming state bar;

6

7 (iii) "Professional assistance program" or
8 "program" means a program or activity relating to drug or
9 alcohol abuse prevention, referral, treatment or
10 rehabilitation, which is directly or indirectly assisted by
11 a board or commission or other organization established
12 under this title for the regulation of licensees or the
13 Wyoming state bar.

14

15 (d) Whether or not the licensee gives his written
16 consent, the content of the record may be disclosed as
17 follows:

18

19 (vi) To the state board or commission regulating
20 the licensee, if the diagnosis or prognosis determines a
21 clearly definable drug or alcohol abuse problem and the
22 licensee refuses to seek treatment.

1 **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon
2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law
3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming
4 Constitution.
