13	(d) Effective January 1, 1986 <u>2006</u>, the number of
14	retail liquor licenses issued shall be based on the
15	following population formula:

1	(ii) Not more than one (1) additional license
2	for each additional five hundred (500) population or major
3	fraction thereof in incorporated cities or towns up to a
4	population of nine thousand five hundred (9,500); and
5	
6	(iii) Not more than one (1) additional license
7	for each additional full three thousand (3,000) population
8	over nine thousand five hundred (9,500) - and up to fifty
9	thousand (50,000); and
10	
11	(iv) Not more than one (1) additional license
12	for each additional full two thousand (2,000) population
13	over fifty thousand (50,000).

15	Section 2. This act is effective January 1, 2006.
