Section 1. W.S. 12-4-201(d) (intro), (ii), (iii) and
by creating a new paragraph (iv) is amended to read:
12-4-201. Retail liquor licenses and malt beverage
permits; population formulas; fees.
(d) Effective January 1, 1986-2006, the number of
retail liquor licenses issued shall be based on the
following population formula:
(ii) Not more than one (1) additional license for each additional five hundred (500) population or major fraction thereof in incorporated cities or towns up to a population of nine thousand five hundred (9,500); and (iii) Not more than one (1) additional license for each additional full three thousand (3,000) population over nine thousand five hundred (9,500)- and up to fifty thousand $(50,000)$; and
for each additional full two thousand (2,000) population over fifty thousand (50,000).

Section 2. This act is effective January 1, 2006. (END)
