Adjutant general positions.

A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to assistant adjutant generals; providing  
2 for a full-time position; providing for a salary; and  
3 providing for an effective date.

5 *Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:*

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 19-7-104(a) is amended to read:

9 **19-7-104. Assistant adjutants general; deputy**  
10 **military administrator and fiscal officer; emergency**  
11 **management coordinator.**

13 (a) The adjutant general shall appoint an assistant  
14 adjutant general for the army national guard and an  
15 assistant adjutant general for the air national guard.  
16 Each assistant adjutant general shall serve in their

1   respective duty positions at the pleasure of the adjutant  
2   general and may be removed from the position by the  
3   adjutant general as provided under W.S. 9-1-202(b)(i).  
4   Each assistant adjutant general shall hold the rank of  
5   brigadier general and shall possess the qualifications set  
6   forth in W.S. 19-7-103(a)(i) through (iii). No person  
7   shall continue to serve as an assistant adjutant general  
8   after failing to qualify before a federal recognition board  
9   for promotion to the grade of brigadier general. At the  
10 discretion of the adjutant general, the adjutant general  
11 may make one (1) of the assistant adjutant general  
12 positions a full-time position. The annual compensation of  
13 the full-time assistant adjutant general shall be the base  
14 pay of an officer holding a comparable federal rank the  
15 same as the armed forces of the United States, with  
16 longevity for appropriate years of military service, to be  
17 paid monthly out of the state treasury as the salaries of  
18 other state officers are paid.

1           **Section 2.** This act is effective immediately upon  
2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law  
3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming  
4 Constitution.
