for

- 1 AN ACT relating to veterans; exempting disabled veterans
- 2 eligible for the disabled veteran's license plates from
- 3 motor vehicle registration fees; modifying license plate
- 4 qualification and vehicle registration provisions; imposing
- 5 reporting duties upon county assessors; and providing for
- 6 an effective date.

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8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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- 10 **Section 1.** W.S. 31-2-215(a) and (b) and 31-3-101(b)
- 11 by creating a new paragraph (xv) are amended to read:

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13 31-2-215. Disabled veteran's license plates.

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1 (a) A disabled veteran who receives fifty percent 2 (50%) or more service connected disability compensation 3 United States department of veteran's from the 4 administration affairs and who is a resident at the time of 5 application under subsection (b) of this section, may apply for distinctive license plates for a motor vehicle owned by 6 him upon registration of the vehicle. These license plates 7 shall be displayed upon the vehicle for which they are 8 9 issued. The license plates shall bear a distinctive symbol 10 or letters identifying the registrant as a disabled 11 veteran. The department shall prescribe the symbol or 12 letters which shall not include arabic numerals designating 13 the county. 14 (b) Application for license plates under subsection 15 16 (a) of this section shall be annually made to the county 17 treasurer as provided by W.S. 31-2-201, except application shall be made not less than thirty (30) days before the 18 19 last day of the applicant's annual registration month. 20 Application forms available at shall be all county treasurer's offices. The normal registration fees shall 21 22 accompany each application. 23

24 31-3-101. Registration fees; exemptions.

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2 (b) The fees prescribed by subsection (a) of this 3 section are modified for owners of the following vehicles:

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5 (xv) A disabled veteran who receives fifty percent (50%) or more service connected disability 6 7 compensation from the United States department of veteran's affairs is exempt from the fees imposed under subsection 8 9 (a) of this section for one (1) vehicle owned by the 10 claimant. Application for the exemption under this 11 paragraph shall be in accordance with W.S. 31-2-215. 12 County assessors shall file notice of the number of 13 exemptions granted and the fiscal impact on revenues in the 14 manner required by W.S. 39-13-102(k).

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Section 2. This act is effective January 1, 2005.
