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             (vii) Any person who omits, neglects or refuses
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    to comply with any duty imposed upon him by this article,
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    or to do or cause to be done any of the things required by
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    this article, or does any act prohibited by this article,
    may, in addition to any other penalty provided by this
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    article, be liable for a penalty of not to exceed one
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1 thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or five (5) times the retail 2 value of the tobacco product at issue, whichever is 3 greater, to be recovered in a civil action; 4 5 (viii) Any person who fails to pay any tax 6 imposed by this article at the time prescribed by law or 7 department rule or regulation may, in addition to any other penalty provided by this article, be liable for a penalty 8 9 of not to exceed five (5) times the tax due, but unpaid, to 10 be recovered in a civil action; 11 12 (ix) Any fixture, equipment or any other 13 material or personal property on the premises of any 14 tobacco product wholesaler or retailer who, with intent to 15 defraud the state, fails to keep or make any record, return, report or inventory, or who keeps or makes any 16 17 false or fraudulent record, return, report or inventory 18 required by this article, or who refuses to pay any tax 19 imposed by this article, or who attempts in any manner to 20 evade or defeat the requirements of this article shall be 21 forfeited to the state; 22 23 (x) Any person who, with intent to defraud,

fails to comply with any requirement of this article or

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1 regulation prescribed hereunder may, in addition to any 2 other penalty provided in this article, for each such 3 offense, be fined not to exceed ten thousand dollars 4 (\$10,000.00), or be imprisoned for not to exceed one (1) 5 year, or both; 6 7 (xi) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the sale or possession for sale of counterfeit cigarettes 8 9 with the intent to defraud by a cigarette manufacturer, 10 importer, wholesaler or retailer may result in the seizure 11 of the product and related machinery by the department or 12 any law enforcement agency and shall be punishable as 13 provided in this paragraph. As used in this paragraph, 14 "counterfeit cigarettes" means cigarettes which have a 15 false manufacturing label or any package of cigarettes which bears a counterfeit tax stamp. Any counterfeit 16 17 cigarettes seized by the department under paragraph (i) of 18 this subsection shall be destroyed. The following 19 penalties shall apply: 20 21 (A) A first violation involving a total 22 quantity of less than two (2) cartons of cigarettes may be 23 punishable by a fine of not to exceed one thousand dollars

2	cigarettes involved, whichever is greater;
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4	(B) A subsequent violation involving a
5	total quantity of less than two (2) cartons of cigarettes
6	may be punishable by a fine of not to exceed five thousand
7	dollars (\$5,000.00) or five (5) times the retail value of
8	the cigarettes involved, whichever is greater;
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LO	(C) A first violation involving a total
L1	quantity of two (2) cartons of cigarettes or more may be
L2	punishable by a fine of not to exceed two thousand dollars
L3	(\$2,000.00) or five (5) times the retail value of the
L 4	cigarettes involved, whichever is greater;

L 6	(D) A subsequent violation involving a
L 7	quantity of two (2) cartons of cigarettes or more shall be
L 8	punishable by a fine of not to exceed fifty thousand
L 9	dollars (\$50,000.00).
