2	authorizing the Wyoming business council to award grants to
3	communities to build, upgrade or repair community buildings
4	that enhance the history, cultural or social needs of the
5	community; requiring a match; granting rulemaking
6	authority; authorizing grantees to contract with private
7	organizations as specified; providing definitions;
8	providing an appropriation and a continuous appropriation
9	of funds; and providing for an effective date.

COMMUNITY ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM

9-12-801. Community enhancement program; purpose;

5 (a) It is the purpose of this article to promote 6 economic revitalization at the city and town level in order 7 to create additional economic health and a stronger state 8 economy.

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The Wyoming business council shall establish and 10 11 administer a Wyoming community enhancement program as 12 provided by this article. Any city or town may submit an 13 application to the council for a grant under the program on forms prescribed by and subject to rules promulgated by the 14 council. Grants may be made by the council for community 15 16 infrastructure projects, including enhancement 17 building, upgrading, repair of community buildings that enhance the history, culture or social needs of the 18 community as determined by the council to be consistent 19 20 with the purposes of this article.

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(c) Grants shall be awarded on the basis of one dollar (\$1.00) from the council for each one dollar (\$1.00) of matching funds from the grantee, up to a maximum grant

(\$100,000.00).

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4 (d) Grants shall be made under this article only if

5 the applicant demonstrates that, upon receipt of the grant,

all projected project costs will be funded. The application 6

7 shall identify the source of all funds to be used for the

project. 8

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10 (e) Grants may be used to fund project costs in

11 accordance with approved applications and rules of the

12 council. The grantee city or town may use grant funds to

13 contract with private, not-for-profit organizations and

community development organizations and state development 14

organizations in accordance with the purposes of this 15

16 article and approved applications.

1 2 9-12-802. Wyoming community enhancement program 3 account. 4 5 There is created the community enhancement account. Funds shall be credited to the account as provided by law. Funds 6 in the account are continuously appropriated to the Wyoming 7 business council to be used only for grants authorized to 8 9 be made under this article and for council expenses in 10 administering the community enhancement program created by 11 this article. 12 13 Section 2. There is appropriated from the budget reserve account to the account created by this act two 14

million dollars (\$2,000,000.00) to be used to implement the 15 purposes of this act. Any unexpended or unobligated funds 16 17 remaining in the account at the end of the biennium ending June 30, 2006 shall not lapse and shall not revert as 18 provided in W.S. 9-4-207. 19

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21 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2005.
