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through 9-2-1708, apply to this section, except the requirement under W.S. 9-2-1707(a)(iii) that public hearings regarding the reorganization plan required under subsection (b) of this section be conducted by at least two (2) interim committees of the legislature shall not apply.

The administrative head of the department shall 7 (b) be a director appointed by the governor not later than 8 9 April 1, 2005. The director shall prepare a plan for 10 reorganization of the agencies, programs and functions 11 specified in this section and submit it to the governor for approval. The department reorganization plan, as approved 12 13 by the governor, shall be submitted to the joint travel, 14 recreation, wildlife and cultural resources interim committee no later than October 15, 2005 and made available 15 16 to the public. The committee shall hold at least one (1) 17 public hearing regarding the plan before the 2006 budget session of the legislature convenes. The joint travel, 18 recreation, wildlife and cultural resources 19 interim 20 committee shall report to the legislature by December 1, 21 2005, its recommendations on the plan, including necessary 22 legislation with respect to the plan. The plan, as approved by the act of the legislature, 23 shall be 24 implemented not later than July 1, 2006.
