- 7 **Section 1.** W.S. 15-11-102, 15-11-104 and 15-11-203
- 8 are amended to read:

- 10 15-11-102. Officers of incorporated town; terms; how
- 11 elected.

- 13 The elective officers of an incorporated town are one (1)
- 14 mayor and four (4) councilmen. The term of office of mayor
- 15 is two (2) years and the term of office of a councilman is

- 1 four (4) years, and until his successor is qualified. They
- 2 are elected at large.

- 4 15-11-104. Officers in city or town with commission
- 5 government; term; how elected.

6

- 7 The elective officers of a city or town adopting the
- 8 commission form of government are a mayor, a commissioner
- 9 of finance and public property, and a commissioner of
- 10 streets and public improvements. The term of the mayor is
- 11 four (4) years and each commissioner is two (2) years and
- 12 until his successor is qualified. They are elected at
- 13 large.

15 15-11-203. Municipality with commission government.

16

- 17 At the first election in a municipality adopting the
- 18 commission form of government, the mayor shall be elected
- 19 to serve a four (4) year term and all other officers shall
- 20 be elected to serve a two (2) year term.

- 22 Section 2. Nothing in this act shall be deemed to
- 23 extend the current term of office of any elected official

2

24 serving on the effective date of this act.

1 Section 3. This act is effective immediately upon

2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

4 Constitution.
