disregard for safety of others; penalties; 1 license 2 revocation. 3 4 (b) Any driver of a motor vehicle who drives or 5 operates the vehicle in willful or wanton disregard of the safety of persons or property while fleeing or eluding a 6 7 pursuing police vehicle is guilty of a felony. 8 9 (b) (c) Every Any person convicted of fleeing or 10 attempting to elude a police officer a violation of 11 subsection (a) of this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00), or 12 13 by imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days, or both. 14 15 16 (d) Any person convicted of a violation of subsection 17 (b) of this section shall be fined not more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00), imprisoned for not less than 18 19 one (1) year nor more than three (3) years, or both. 20 21 (e) Any person convicted of a violation of subsection 22 (b) of this section shall, in addition to the penalties 23 imposed by this section, have his driver's license revoked 24 pursuant to W.S. 31-7-127(a).
