1 (k) The order shall specifically state the period of 2 time for which it is effective, as determined pursuant to 3 W.S. 35-21-106(b). 4 5 35-21-106. Service of order; duration and extension of order; violation; remedies not exclusive. 6 7 (b) An order of protection granted by the court shall 8 9 be effective for a fixed period of time not to exceed three 10 (3) months as determined by the court. The order may be 11 extended repetitively for good cause upon motion of the 12 petitioner for additional periods of time not to exceed three (3) months each as determined by the court. The 13 14 filing of an action for divorce shall not supersede an order of protection granted under this act. 15 16 Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2005. 17 18 19 (END)
