14	(a) As used in the statutes unless the legislature
15	clearly specifies a different meaning or interpretation or
16	the context clearly requires a different meaning:

1 2 (x) "District attorney" means and includes a 3 county and prosecuting attorney; in a county where the 4 office of district attorney has not been created. This 5 definition shall specifically not apply to W.S. 9-1-801 through 9-1-811; 6 7 8 18-3-301. Office created; qualifications; certificate 9 of election; counties empowered to consolidate. 10 11 (a) In judicial districts in which the office of district attorney has not been created There shall be 12 13 elected in each county a county and prosecuting attorney who at the time of his nomination and election and during 14 his term of office, shall be a member of the bar of this 15 state. A copy of his certificate of election and oath 16 17 shall be filed by the county and prosecuting attorney with the clerk of the district court for his county or counties. 18 In those judicial districts in which the office of district 19 20 attorney has been created the county commissioners shall 21 appoint an attorney to the office of county attorney for a 22 term of one (1) year, who may be reappointed on a 23 year-to-year basis. The county commissioners may remove the 24 county attorney for cause.

1 2 (b) The boards of county commissioners of two (2) or 3 more contiguous counties not served by a district attorney 4 may by resolution consolidate the offices of, and agree to 5 be served by, a single county and prosecuting attorney who shall be elected by a vote of the electors of all the 6 7 counties within the consolidated area. 8 9 Section 2. W.S. 9-1-801 through 9-1-811 and 10 18-3-302(b) are repealed. 11 Section 3. 12 13 14 (a) This act shall: 15 16 (i) Not apply to any district attorney duly 17 elected and currently serving his term of office; 18 19 (ii) Apply following the conclusion of any term 20 of office of a district attorney currently serving his term 21 of office as provided by Wyoming Constitution, Article 6, 22 Section 17. 23
