- 1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming senior services trust fund;
- 2 creating the Wyoming senior services trust fund; requiring
- 3 an audit and a report; amending a definition; providing an
- 4 appropriation; and providing for an effective date.

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6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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8 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-2-1216 is created to read:

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- 10 9-2-1216. Wyoming senior services trust fund
- 11 established; corpus inviolate; investment by state
- 12 treasurer.

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- 14 (a) An account is established which shall be referred
- 15 to as the Wyoming senior services trust fund. The trust
- 16 fund shall consist of those funds designated to the account

1 by law and other contributions, grants, gifts, bequests and

2 donations to the trust fund.

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4 (b) monies deposited into the trust The 5 established pursuant to this section are inviolate and constitute a permanent or perpetual trust fund. The monies 6 shall be transmitted to the state treasurer for credit to 7 the trust fund and shall be invested by the state treasurer 8 9 as authorized under W.S. 9-4-711 in a manner to obtain the 10 highest return possible consistent with the preservation of 11 the corpus. The investment interest earned from investment 12 of the corpus of the trust fund shall be annually credited 13 by the state treasurer not later than June 30 of each year

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as follows:

16 (i) All investment interest earned up to an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the corpus of the trust fund shall be deposited into a separate account and distributed in accordance with W.S. 9-2-1214;

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(ii) Any investment interest earned in excess of the amount specified in paragraph (i) of this subsection shall be credited by the state treasurer to the trust fund established by subsection (a) of this section.

Biennial report by board. 12 13 (a) Beginning September 1, 2003, the board shall 14 report to the division on aging, the governor and the joint 15 labor, health and social services interim committee no 16 later than September 1 of each odd-numbered year with 17 respect to the grants awarded, and how those grants have 18 benefited senior citizens in the state. 19 20 21 (b) The director of the department of audit or his 22 designee shall audit the trust fund created by W.S.

9-2-1216 biennially. The initial audit shall occur not

later than June 30, 2006. A report on the audit shall be

provided to the division on aging, the board, the governor 1 2 and the joint labor, health and social services interim 3 committee no later than December 31 of the year in which 4 the audit occurs. 5 6 Section 3. There is appropriated thirty million 7 dollars (\$30,000,000.00) from the budget reserve account to 8 the Wyoming senior services trust fund created by this act, effective July 1, 2005. 9 10 11 Section 4. This act is effective July 1, 2005. 12
