A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to gaming; authorizing the sale of pull
- 2 tabs under certain conditions; providing definitions;
- 3 providing penalties; and providing for an effective date.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

7 **Section 1.** W.S. 11-25-114 is created to read:

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- 9 11-25-114. Pull tab selling permits; authorized
- 10 sales; penalties.

11

- 12 (a) The commission may issue permits to sell pull
- 13 tabs at any premise where a pari-mutuel event is
- 14 authorized. The commission shall supervise the conduct of
- 15 all pull tab permittees provided for and regulated by this
- 16 section and shall make reasonable rules and regulations for

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1 the control, supervision and direction of applicants and

2 permittees. The commission may require that permit

3 applicants be fingerprinted for identification purposes as

4 a condition of receiving a permit. The commission shall

5 establish reasonable fees for permits provided for by this

6 section. The fees shall be established to ensure that the

7 costs of administering this section are recovered through

8 the permit fees.

9

10 (b) Each permittee and all permittee employees shall

11 be licensed by the commission and shall comply with all

12 rules and regulations and all orders issued by the

13 commission. No person shall sell any pull tabs pursuant to

14 this section without obtaining a permit. The commission is

15 authorized to access criminal history record information in

16 accordance with W.S. 9-1-627(d) for all licensees and

17 permittees selling pull tabs.

18

19 (c) The commission may designate a representative to

20 enforce rules of the commission and this section. The

21 representative shall exercise such reasonable and necessary

22 authority as is designated by rules of the commission

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23 including the following:

11 or association the operation or management of the pull tab

12 sales permitted under this section or permit any other

13 person, corporation or association to retain any of the

monies received from the sale of pull tabs. The commission 14

shall revoke the permit of any permittee for any violation 15

16 of the foregoing condition and such acts are a violation of

this section. 17

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(e) Applications for permits to sell pull tabs shall 19 20 be made to the commission and shall fully identify the 21 applicant, include a proper financial statement showing the 22 financial responsibility of the applicant, and the arrangements for the payment due on the sale of pull tabs, 23 the names and identification of those to supervise the sale 24

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1 of pull tabs and the controls and supervision by the

2 permittee. The commission shall approve all equipment used

3 in the sale of pull tabs.

4

5 (f) The commission may issue, amend or refuse to

6 issue permits or licenses in its discretion.

7

8 (g) The commission or representatives of the

9 commission shall have access to the books and records of

10 the pull tab permittees regarding the sale and payouts of

11 permittees authorized under this section.

12

13 (h) It is unlawful for any person to give or promise

14 to give or attempt to give or for any person to receive or

15 agree to receive or attempt to receive, any money, bribe or

16 thing of value with intent to influence any person to

17 dishonestly permit, manage, direct or participate in the

18 sale of any pull tab sold under this section with the

19 intention or purpose that the randomly selected result of

20 the pull tab will be affected. Violation of this

21 subsection is a felony punishable by imprisonment for not

22 more than five (5) years, a fine of not more than five

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thousand dollars (\$5,000.00), or both.

commission is guilty of a misdemeanor.

(j) The commission or the representative of the commission may exclude from attendance at or near any pull tab selling premises as authorized by this section any person who has been convicted of violating subsection (h) of this section and any person who refuses to leave when ordered to do so by the commission or representative of the

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(k) Any person, corporation or association selling 9 10 pull tabs pursuant to this section without a permit issued 11 in accordance with this section or any person, corporation 12 or association who violates any other provision of this 13 section except as provided for in subsection (h) of this 14 section is quilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not more than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00), imprisoned for 15 not more than six (6) months, or both. 16

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Section 2. W.S. 6-7-101(a)(iii)(E), (G) and by creating a new subparagraph (H), 9-1-627(d), 11-25-102(a)(viii) and by creating a new paragraph (xii) and 11-25-109(c) are amended to read:

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23 **6-7-101. Definitions.**

1 (a) As used in this article: 2 (iii) "Gambling" means risking any property for 3 4 gain contingent in whole or in part upon lot, chance, the 5 operation of a gambling device or the happening or outcome of an event, including a sporting event, over which the 6 7 person taking a risk has no control, but does not include: 8 9 (E) Any game, wager or transaction which is 10 incidental to a bona fide social relationship, is 11 participated in by natural persons only, and in which no 12 person is participating, directly or indirectly, in 13 professional gambling; -or 14 15 (G) Display or private use of antique 16 gambling devices in the owner's residence; - or 17 18 (H) Pull tab sales authorized by the 19 Wyoming pari-mutuel commission under W.S. 11-25-114. 20 21 9-1-627. Authority to compile, disseminate exchange information; immunity; access to information 22 23 limited; security precautions.

1 (d) Access to criminal history record information is available to the Wyoming pari-mutuel commission as provided 2 3 by W.S. 11-25-104(j) and 11-25-114(b). The commission 4 shall take reasonable security precautions to prevent 5 unauthorized persons from gaining access to criminal history record information in accordance with rules and 6 7 regulations established by the Wyoming division of criminal investigation. For the purpose of this subsection 8 "criminal history record information" means information, 9 10 records and data compiled by criminal justice agencies on 11 individuals for the purpose of identifying criminal 12 offenders consisting of identifiable descriptions of the offenders and notations or 13 summary of а 14 detentions, indictments, information, pre-trial proceedings, nature and disposition of criminal charges, 15 16 sentencing, rehabilitation, incarceration, correctional 17 supervision and release. Criminal history record information is limited to information recorded as the 18 result of the initiation of criminal proceedings. It does 19 20 not include intelligence data, analytical prosecutorial 21 files, investigative reports and files of statistical 22 records and reports in which individual identities are not 23 ascertainable.
