## HOUSE BILL NO. HB0228

School finance-model recalibration.

## A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to school finance; establishing a select 2 committee to conduct school finance model recalibration; 3 providing for model recalibration subject to management

4 council approval; imposing duties upon the department of

5 education pertaining to school finance data requirements;

6 providing funds for school finance litigation; providing

7 appropriations; authorizing additional positions; and

8 providing for an effective date.

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10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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12 Section 1.

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14 (a) There is created a select committee on school

15 finance recalibration consisting of the following members:

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(i) Five (5) members of the Wyoming senate appointed by the president of the senate, one (1) of whom shall be the chairman of the senate education committee and one (1) a member of the senate appropriations committee;

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6 (ii) Five (5) members of the Wyoming house of
7 representatives appointed by the speaker of the house of
8 representatives, one (1) of whom shall be the chairman of
9 the house education committee and one (1) a member of the
10 house appropriations committee.

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12 The select committee shall undertake a study to (b) 13 recalibrate the education resource block grant model in accordance with W.S. 21-13-309(t) to 14 determine modifications are necessary to ensure the model remains 15 16 cost-based light of changing conditions in 17 modifications to the law, and shall administer the contract with professional consultants to the legislature for model 18 recalibration as approved by the management council. A 19 20 recalibration, together report on with 21 legislation, shall be provided to the legislature in 22 sufficient time for consideration during the 2006 budget session. The select committee may introduce legislation as 23 24 other committees of the legislature.

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2 (c) The select committee shall elect a chairman. The 3 legislative service office shall provide staff services to

4 the committee.

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6 (d) There is appropriated from the general fund to
7 the legislative service office fifty thousand dollars
8 (\$50,000.00) which shall be used to fund necessary expenses
9 of the select committee.

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Section 2. Seven hundred sixty thousand dollars 11 12 (\$760,000.00) is appropriated from the general fund to the legislative service office to fund model recalibration in 13 accordance with section 1 of this act. Funds appropriated 14 under this section shall be expended in accordance with the 15 16 contractual agreement entered into between the management 17 council and professional consultants to the legislature for recalibration of the education resource block grant model. 18

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20 **Section 3.** Five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) is appropriated from the general fund to the attorney general for funding expenses associated with school finance litigation involved in the school equity

1 foundation lawsuit and incurred by state's counsel for

2 school finance litigation.

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## 4 Section 4.

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(a) Nine hundred seventy-three thousand five hundred 6 7 eighty-six dollars (\$973,586.00) is appropriated from the general fund to the department of education to improve the 8 9 quality and availability of data necessary for computations under the education resource block grant model and for 10 11 model recalibration efforts conducted by the legislature in accordance with sections 1 and 2 of this act. 12 The 13 department shall provide support to school districts in ensuring data quality and timeliness, shall generate 14 additional data required by model recalibration and shall: 15

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(i) Modify rules, policies, practices and procedures for improving the accuracy of school data, the efficiency of the data collection process and for ensuring uniform and standardized treatment of school data for school district reporting purposes;

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(ii) Develop processes and procedures ensuring 1 2 district compliance with standardized and uniform data 3 treatment and reporting; 4 5 (iii) Establish data validation procedures. 6 7 (b) The department is authorized an additional five (5) full-time positions to implement subsection (a) of this 8 9 section, and may expend funds appropriated under this section for contractual services. 10 11 Section 5. Appropriations authorized under this act 12 shall be for the period commencing upon the effective date 13 of this act and ending June 30, 2006. 14 15 16 Section 6. This act is effective immediately upon 17 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law 18 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming 19 Constitution. 20
