Animal control and community service officers retirement.

## A BILL

for

1 AN ACT relating to the Wyoming retirement system; authorizing municipal animal control and community service 2 officers to participate in the law enforcement retirement 3 system; amending a definition; permitting employers to pay 4 5 the difference between coverage under the retirement system and the law enforcement retirement system for municipal 6 7 animal control and community service officers; conditioning 8 implementation upon receipt of required payments transfer of covered animal control and community service 9 officers as specified; providing for funding; and providing 10 11 for an effective date.

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13 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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15 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-3-402(a) (xviii) and 9-3-432(b) are

16 amended to read:

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2 9-3-402. Definitions.

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4 (a) As used in this article:

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(xviii) "Law enforcement officer" or "officer" 6 7 means any member who is a county sheriff, deputy county 8 sheriff, municipal police officer, duly authorized 9 investigator of the Wyoming livestock board meeting the 10 specifications of W.S. 7-2-101(a)(iv)(E), investigator 11 employed by the Wyoming state board of outfitters and 12 professional guides meeting the specifications of W.S. 7-2-101(a)(iv)(J), Wyoming correctional officer, Wyoming 13 law enforcement academy instructor, University of Wyoming 14 15 campus police officer, detention officer or dispatcher for 16 law enforcement agencies. Law enforcement officer also 17 includes municipal animal control or community services 18 officers when the municipal employer and employee have 19 agreed to fund benefits provided to law enforcement 20 officers under W.S. 9-3-432;

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- 22 9-3-432. Law enforcement officers; contributions;
- 23 benefit eligibility; service and disability benefits; death
- 24 benefits; benefit options.

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2	(b) Except as otherwise provided, each employer of a
3	law enforcement officer covered under this article shall
4	pay into the account a contribution equal to eight and six-
5	tenths percent (8.6%) of the salary paid to each of its law
6	enforcement officers covered under this article and may pay
7	into the account any amount of the officer's share of
8	contributions under subsection (a) of this section. $\underline{\text{For}}$
9	municipal animal control and community service officers,
10	the employer may pay the difference between the
11	contribution required by W.S. 9-3-412(a) and the
12	contribution required by this section. For municipal
13	animal control and community service officers, if the
14	employer does not pay the difference between the
15	contribution required by W.S. 9-3-412(a) and the
16	contribution required by this section, the municipal animal
17	control or community service officer shall pay the amount.
18	Payments under this subsection shall be made monthly to the
19	account in accordance with W.S. 9-3-413 and are subject to
20	the penalties imposed under W.S. 9-3-413 for delinquent
21	contributions. No additional contribution shall be imposed
22	upon the state, any city, town or county for benefits
23	provided law enforcement officers under this article.

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3 (a) Each employer with animal control or community 4 service officers covered under the Wyoming retirement

5 system shall on or before June 30, 2005:

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7 (i) Pay amounts necessary to the retirement

8 account for maintaining the actuarial integrity of the

9 account and funding all liability arising from transferring

10 its covered animal control or community service officers to

11 the retirement system for coverage under W.S. 9-3-432, or

12 for expanding retirement system coverage under W.S.

13 9-3-432, as of the date of entry into the system or

14 expansion of coverage, as applicable;

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16 (ii) Transfer the covered animal control or

17 community service officers for coverage under W.S. 9-3-432

18 or ensure retirement system coverage for its animal control

19 and community service officers under W.S. 9-3-432, as

20 applicable, as of the date of entry or expansion of

21 coverage.

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23 (b) Coverage of animal control and community service

24 officers under W.S. 9-3-432 shall not be implemented by the

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1 Wyoming retirement board until funds payable to the Wyoming

2 retirement system are received as required by this section

3 for deposit into the retirement account, as necessary for

4 maintaining the actuarial integrity of the account and

5 funding all liability arising under this act, for years of

6 service prior to the date of entry or expansion of

7 coverage.

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9 (c) In addition to subsection (b) of this section,

10 coverage of animal control and community service officers

11 under W.S. 9-3-432 shall not be implemented by the Wyoming

12 retirement board until funds necessary for maintaining the

13 actuarial integrity of the account and funding any

14 liability arising under this act, are deposited into the

15 Wyoming retirement account, and contributions required

16 under W.S. 9-3-432(a) and (b) are paid to the Wyoming

17 retirement system for deposit into the retirement account

18 for at least two (2) months of covered service following

19 the date of entry or expansion of coverage, as applicable.

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21 Section 3. This act is effective July 1, 2005.
