14	a licensed retailer in this state, the out-of-state shipper

1	(ii) Pay a license fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00)
2	two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) to the liquor division
3	which shall be prorated if issued for less than one (1)
4	full year;
5	
6	(e) The out of state shipper shall annually renew its
7	license with the liquor division by paying a renewal fee of
8	fifty dollars (\$50.00) <u>two hundred fifty dollars</u> (\$250.00),
9	providing a true copy of its current alcoholic liquor or
10	malt beverage license issued in its state of domicile, and
11	further providing other information as may be required.
12	
13	Section 2. This act is effective July 1, 2005.
