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- 11 (a) The Wyoming legislature recognizes that substance
- 12 abuse continues to be a problem in Wyoming public schools
- 13 and drug testing would assist school districts in
- 14 identifying, intervening and treating students with
- 15 substance abuse problems before reaching the age of
- 16 majority and entering the criminal justice system. Based

1 upon test results, school districts could employ a

2 combination of responses to address the prevention,

3 treatment, education and awareness of substance abuse by

4 their students.

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6 (b) To assist school districts with drug testing and prevention programs, a district may apply to the department 7 education for state assistance to fund expenses 8 9 associated with planning and implementing testing programs for the unlawful use of controlled substances within the 10 11 boundaries of property used by the district primarily for 12 the education of students in grades seven (7) through twelve (12), including within school vehicles and at 13 facilities in which school activities and events are held. 14 The application shall be on a form and in a manner 15 16 specified by the department and shall include a description

The department shall by rule and regulation establish a procedure for reviewing district applications 10 11 and for awarding assistance subject to the following: 12 13 (i) District allocations shall be made from 14 funds appropriated by the legislature under section 2 of 15 this act; 16 17 (ii) Each applicant district approved by the department shall be allocated an amount equal to the 18 19 greater of the following: 20 21 (A) Ten dollars (\$10.00) per ADM within 22 grade levels targeted by the district's program specified within its application, plus ten thousand 23 dollars (\$10,000.00) for program administration; or 24

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2 (B) Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00).

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(iii) In the event amounts appropriated under section 2 of this act are insufficient for payments under this section, the department shall make a pro rata reduction in the distributions to all approved district programs.
