- 15 (d) An amount shall be computed for each high school
- 16 within each school district in accordance with the
- 17 following:

2 (iii) The amount computed under paragraph (ii) 3 of this subsection shall be multiplied by the vocational 4 education amount contained within the teacher salaries and 5 benefits component of the prototypical school model for grades nine (9) through twelve (12), as specified under 6 W.S. 21-13-309(m)(ii)(C), as recalibrated for the 2001-20027 school year; subject to reallocation limitations imposed 8 9 by the education resource block grant model for school year 2001-2002; 10

Section 2. Section 1 of this act eliminates a 12 13 limitation imposed upon the reinsertion of the vocational education amount within the teacher salaries and benefits 14 component of the education resource block grant model 15 following application of the weight factor prescribed by 16 17 W.S. 21-13-329(d)(ii). By elimination of this limitation, the legislature recognizes the adjustment exceeds the 18 requirements necessary to ensure the education resource 19 20 block grant model is cost-based. The modification to this adjustment as authorized under section 1 of this act shall 21 applied commencing with school year 22 2005-2006 be computations and each school year thereafter until the 23 adjustment is recalibrated in accordance with law. 24
