A BILL

for

- 1 AN ACT relating to the administration of government;
- 2 authorizing state elected officials to designate personal
- 3 representatives to boards and commissions as specified;
- 4 repealing unnecessary language and otherwise making
- 5 conforming amendments; and providing for an effective date.

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7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Wyoming:

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9 **Section 1.** W.S. 9-1-103 is created to read:

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- 11 9-1-103. State elected officials representation on
- 12 boards and commissions; designees; limitations.

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- 14 A state elected official may authorize a designee to act as
- 15 the official's personal representative to any board or
- 16 commission of which the official is a member. The designee
- 17 shall have the right to speak on behalf of the official and

to vote and take other lawful action on behalf of the 1

- 2 official as a member of the board or commission. The
- 3 provisions of this section shall not apply to any board or
- 4 commission to which the state elected official is appointed
- 5 by the Wyoming constitution or which is comprised solely of
- state elected officials. 6

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- **Section 2.** W.S. 9-1-207(b), 9-2-2501(a), 11-2-102(a), 8
- 9 11-5-401(a)(ii), 14-8-104(a)(ii), 21-16-703(b)(i) and (ii),
- 21-18-201(c), 21-22-103(a)(v) and (vi) and 30-4-102 are 10
- 11 amended to read:

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- 13 9-1-207. State planning coordinator; appointment;
- qualifications; term; removal; powers; duties. 14

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- 16 In fulfilling the provisions of W.S. 9-1-215, the
- 17 coordinator may sit as the governor's personal
- representative on all nonconstitutionally created boards 18
- and commissions which are not exclusively licensing in 19
- 20 nature. The coordinator shall have the right to speak on
- 21 behalf of the governor but not to vote. The coordinator
- 22 shall not sit as the governor's personal representative for
- 23 purposes of fulfilling the provisions of W.S. 9-1-215 on

any boards or commissions on which one (1) or more of the other four (4) elective state officers sit.

9-2-2501. Wyoming on-line government commission;

duties; electronic transaction of business.

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7 (a) There is created a Wyoming on-line government
8 commission. Membership on the commission shall consist of
9 the governor, secretary of state, state auditor, state
10 treasurer and state superintendent of public instruction.
11 or their designees. Each member shall have one (1) vote.
12 One (1) member shall be elected annually to act as chairman
13 of the commission.

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15 **11-2-102.** Composition; qualifications; appointment 16 and removal of members; quorum.

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18 (a) The board shall consist of nine (9) members,
19 including the governor or his designated representative and
20 the dean of the University of Wyoming college of
21 agriculture or his designated representative as ex officio
22 nonvoting members. Seven (7) members shall be appointed by
23 the governor with the advice and consent of the senate and
24 may be removed by the governor as provided in W.S. 9-1-202.

- 1 One (1) member shall be appointed from each of the seven $\left(1\right) = \left(1\right$
- 2 (7) appointment districts pursuant to W.S. 9-1-218.
- 3 Appointments in each appointment district shall be rotated
- 4 among the several counties comprising the district.

2 completion of all acts necessary for a bill to become law

3 as provided by Article 4, Section 8 of the Wyoming

4 Constitution.
