He The 14 state forester shall have a bachelor's degree in forestry less than four (4) years experience 15 with not professional forestry work. The state forester shall, under 16 17 the general supervision of the board director, have direction of all forest interest and all matters pertaining 18 to forestry within the jurisdiction of the state of 19 20 Wyoming; and may, with approval of the board director, 21 appoint such assistants and employees as are necessary in 22 executing the duties of his office.
